THE PROMISE

A New Covenant

JEREMIAH 31:31-34 · NASB 2020

31 “Behold, days are coming,” declares the Lord, “when I will make a new covenant with the house of Israel and the house of Judah, **32** not like the covenant which I made with their fathers on the day I took them by the hand to bring them out of the land of Egypt, My covenant which they broke, although I was a husband to them,” declares the Lord. **33** “For this is the covenant which I will make with the house of Israel after those days,” declares the Lord: “I will put My law within them and write it on their heart; and I will be their God, and they shall be My people. **34** They will not teach again, each one his neighbor and each one his brother, saying, ‘Know the Lord,’ for they will all know Me, from the least of them to the greatest of them,” declares the Lord, “for I will forgive their wrongdoing, and their sin I will no longer remember.”

THE COVENANT AT SINAI

What Was the Old Covenant That Was Broken?

EXODUS 19:5 · NASB 2020

5 Now then, if you will indeed obey My voice and keep My covenant, then you shall be My own possession among all the peoples, for all the earth is Mine;

EXODUS 24:6-8 · NASB 2020

6 Moses took half of the blood and put it in basins, and the other half of the blood he sprinkled on the altar. **7** Then he took the Book of the Covenant and read it as the people listened; and they said, “All that the Lord has spoken we will do, and we will be obedient!” **8** So Moses took the blood and sprinkled it on the people, and said, “Behold the blood of the covenant, which the Lord has made with you in accordance with all these words.”

THE BLESSING OF HIS PRESENCE

What Happens When You Keep God's Covenant?

EXODUS 24:9-11 · NASB 2020

9 Then Moses went up with Aaron, Nadab and Abihu, and seventy of the elders of Israel, **10** and they saw the God of Israel; and under His feet there appeared to be a pavement of sapphire, as clear as the sky itself. **11** Yet He did not reach out with His hand against the nobles of the sons of Israel; and they saw God, and they ate and drank.

THE LAST SUPPER

The New Covenant Revealed

MATTHEW 26:26-28 · NASB 2020

26 Now while they were eating, Jesus took some bread, and after a blessing, He broke it and gave it to the disciples, and said, "Take, eat; this is My body." **27** And when He had taken a cup and given thanks, He gave it to them, saying, "Drink from it, all of you; **28** for this is My blood of the covenant, which is being poured out for many for forgiveness of sins."

An Example of Prayer to the Lord

JEREMIAH 32:16-22 · NASB 2020

16 "After giving the deed of purchase to Baruch the son of Neriah, I prayed to the Lord, saying, **17** 'Oh, Lord God! Behold, You Yourself have made the heavens and the earth by Your great power and by Your outstretched arm! Nothing is too difficult for You, **18** who shows mercy to thousands, but repays the wrongdoing of fathers into the laps of their children after them, great and mighty God. The Lord of armies is His name; **19** great in counsel and mighty in deed, whose eyes are open to all the ways of the sons of mankind, giving to everyone according to his ways and according to the fruit of his deeds; **20** who has accomplished signs and wonders in the land of Egypt, and even to this day both in Israel and among mankind; and You have made a name for Yourself, as at this day. **21** You brought Your people Israel out of the land of Egypt with signs and with wonders, and with a strong hand and an outstretched arm, and with great terror; **22** and You gave them this land, which You swore to their forefathers to give them, a land flowing with milk and honey.

JEREMIAH 32:26-27 · NASB 2020

26 Then the word of the Lord came to Jeremiah, saying, **27** "Behold, I am the Lord, the God of all flesh; is anything too difficult for Me?"
